Four Ways To Give

The Damascus Trust depends primarily on gifts and donations to meet our financial needs. If you would like to help our ministry in this way then here are the options:

If you do pay tax:

1. **Gift Aid** - the recent changes in Gift Aid have made things much easier all round. By completing the simple form opposite, we can re-claim tax paid on any sized donation. This applies to both regular gifts such as standing orders or to occasional gifts and the amounts can vary. So it really is an opportunity not to be missed!

If you don't pay tax:

2. **Standing Orders** - these can be made on a monthly, weekly or annual basis. Giving in this way is of particular value as it provides us with regular income and so enables us to plan ahead.
3. **One-off Gifts** - these are always appreciated however large or small. Often God has used these gifts to meet specific needs.

One more way to give:

4. **Legacy gifts** - You can also include Damascus Trust as a beneficiary in your Will. For further details please tick the box at the bottom of the next page.
